When forming the earth, God took six days to complete and rested on the seventh day. He did not let Moses enter into His rest until the seventh day. This is the Old Testament. However, now we don't have to take one day to rest and follow the Law. Every day is a day of rest in the Lord by praise and worship, seeking His face by mediating on the Word to find out His purpose for you.

Questions to ask when studying the topic: who, what, when, how and why? Also, how does this apply to my life.
