

How to Study the Bible & Receive Revelations from God

The scriptures are the road map. The words are referred to as the letter. As we start to read, it is necessary to learn the meaning of the words in the Hebrew and Greek text. Studying allows us to know what has been written and detect errors during translation from one language to another. Revelation comes from the Spirit. With the letter and the Spirit, a message can be taught to others who don't understand the truth.

Materials

King James Bible
Strong's Exhaustive Concordance
Dictionary
Find books about the culture during Biblical times

You can study only one word or a subject.

Let's begin with the topic "Glory of the Lord".

Look up the words Glory and Lord separately:

1. Open the Concordance.
2. Look up the word glory – alphabetically in the front of the Concordance and browse until you see the word glory,
3. Read the brief descriptions to see what might fit the category.

The first scripture: Genesis 31:1 – hath he gotten all the g'
(g' means glory)

Look up the entire scripture in the bible – it does not fit the category.

Next scripture: Genesis 45:13 – it does not fit either.

Go down the list to find scriptures that are about the topic:

Exodus 16:10	Exodus 24:16-17
Exodus 33:18 & 33:22	Exodus 40:34-35
Leviticus 9:6 & 9:23	Numbers 14:10 & 14:21-22

You continue until you find enough scriptures for subject. We will stop here since this is only an example.

If any of the scriptures are repetitious, eliminate one but be sure to *check the contents to see if a few words may be different*, then that scripture can be used as added value.
